

## CONSTRUCTION NOTIFICATION – MONA VALE JANUARY 2018



### **B-LINE SERVICES AVAILABLE NOW**

A fleet of modern yellow double deck buses are providing frequent and reliable services between Monavale and Wynyard.

Customers can catch B-Line from the new B-Line branded bus stops at Monavale, Warriewood, Narrabeen, Collaroy, Dee Why, Brookvale, Manly Vale, Spit Junction (Mosman), Neutral Bay and Wynyard.

These services are proposed to be extended to Newport in 2018.

There is no need to plan your trip on B-Line – it is a turn up and go service, 7 days a week, running from 4.30am until 12.30am. Customers are encouraged to plan their journey at [transportnsw.info](http://transportnsw.info) or by downloading real-time transport apps. Updates are available by following @BusesNorth on Twitter or phoning the Transport Info Line on 131 500.

B-Line bus services provide more seats, more on-board comfort and more services, more often. Other benefits include in-seat USB chargers and priority seating for people with accessibility needs.

### **PARKING ON THE NORTHERN BEACHES**

With the introduction of B-Line, six new car parks, providing up to 900 new car spaces for commuters have been commissioned or are currently being constructed. Upon completion, each of these car parks will provide accessible parking, bike racks or sheds. Each car park has been designed for public transport customers to easily connect to a nearby transport hub or B-Line stop. Commuter car parking is available at the following locations:

- PCYC Building, Civic Parade, Dee Why
- Corner of Pittwater Road and William Street, Brookvale (opposite Warringah Mall)
- Berry Reserve car park, Pittwater Road, Narrabeen
- Beeby Reserve car park, corner of Barrenjoey Road and Golf Avenue, Monavale

Commuter car parking at the North Narrabeen Reserve, Pittwater Road, Warriewood, is currently under construction and scheduled to be operational in the coming months. Commuter car parking at Manly Vale, at the corner of Condamine Street and Kenneth Road, is also under construction and is scheduled to be operational in 2018.

## WORKS CONTINUE ALONG THE ROAD CORRIDOR IN 2018

There are a series of road improvements across the Northern Beaches and Lower North Shore designed to help traffic flow more easily and make bus services more reliable.

Public transport users and community members will continue to see works such as new or extended turning lanes, tidal flow systems, bus bays and other road changes progressively completed in 2018. These road improvements are designed to ease congestion on roads along the B-Line route.

## ROAD WORK

In Mona Vale, road work will continue on Barrenjoey Road and Golf Avenue. From **7 January**, work will include:

- finishing work to the bus indent near Village Park
- traffic island adjustments at the intersection of Pittwater and Barrenjoey Road and Golf Avenue and Park Street including drainage, traffic signal and pavement works
- asphaltting finishing works

## CAR PARK WORK

From **7 January**, car park work will include:

- finishing work
- all remaining work will require closure of up to 8 parking bays

## TRAFFIC CHANGES

Traffic conditions will change along Barrenjoey and Pittwater Roads while construction continues. Temporary fencing, traffic control, and signs will be in place for public safety.

## DAY WORK

Work will occur at the sites located on the map during the following hours:

- 7am to 6pm on Monday to Friday
- 8am to 1pm on Saturday

## NIGHT WORK

Following on from community feedback, we will continue with the revised construction program of working up to five consecutive nights per week followed by two nights' respite. Working up to five consecutive nights means that we can complete more work in a shorter timeframe, reduce the total number of nights worked in your area and reduce the overall construction timeframe. Working at night is also required for the safety of pedestrians, motorists and workers, whilst minimising traffic impacts. The works schedule is weather dependent and subject to change.

Where night work is happening, site set up activities will start from 7pm. Construction work is scheduled from 9pm and will continue to 6am. Please check the B-Line website for any updates on the night work program in your area.

## MINIMISING COMMUNITY IMPACT

Some of the work will be noisy and we try to reduce the noise when we can.

Some ways we do this include:

- using barriers and sound blankets to reduce the noise
- the use of squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles
- only using noisy machinery when we absolutely have to
- doing noisy work early in the evening when possible
- directing the noise and lights away from residents when we can
- talking to residents before the work starts, to let them know what to expect.
